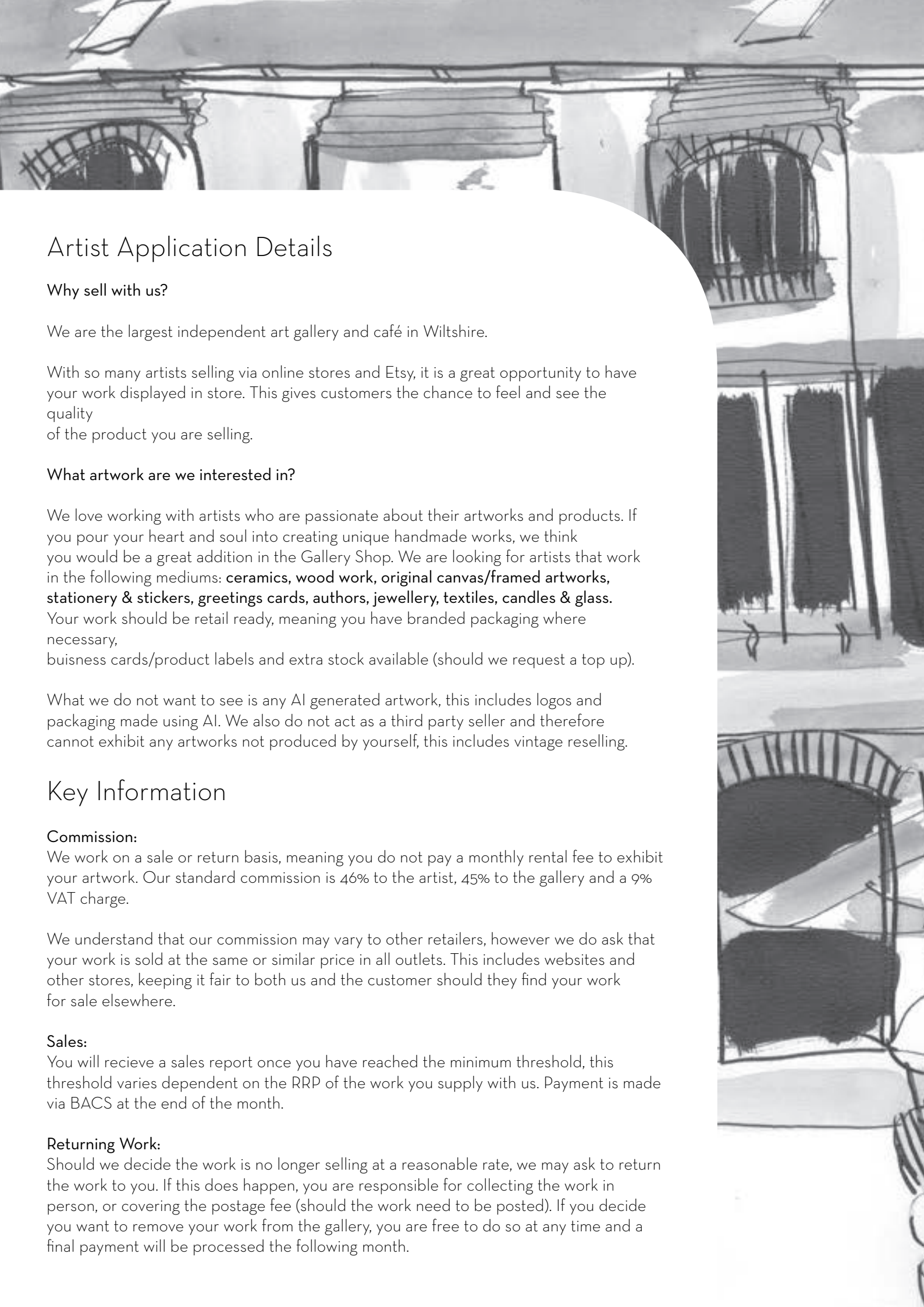

Artist Application Details

Why sell with us?

We are the largest independent art gallery and café in Wiltshire.

With so many artists selling via online stores and Etsy, it is a great opportunity to have your work displayed in store. This gives customers the chance to feel and see the quality of the product you are selling.

What artwork are we interested in?

We love working with artists who are passionate about their artworks and products. If you pour your heart and soul into creating unique handmade works, we think you would be a great addition in the Gallery Shop. We are looking for artists that work in the following mediums: **ceramics, wood work, original canvas/framed artworks, stationery & stickers, greetings cards, authors, jewellery, textiles, candles & glass.** Your work should be retail ready, meaning you have branded packaging where necessary, business cards/product labels and extra stock available (should we request a top up).

What we do not want to see is any AI generated artwork, this includes logos and packaging made using AI. We also do not act as a third party seller and therefore cannot exhibit any artworks not produced by yourself, this includes vintage reselling.

Key Information

Commission:

We work on a sale or return basis, meaning you do not pay a monthly rental fee to exhibit your artwork. Our standard commission is 46% to the artist, 45% to the gallery and a 9% VAT charge.

We understand that our commission may vary to other retailers, however we do ask that your work is sold at the same or similar price in all outlets. This includes websites and other stores, keeping it fair to both us and the customer should they find your work for sale elsewhere.

Sales:

You will receive a sales report once you have reached the minimum threshold, this threshold varies dependent on the RRP of the work you supply with us. Payment is made via BACS at the end of the month.

Returning Work:

Should we decide the work is no longer selling at a reasonable rate, we may ask to return the work to you. If this does happen, you are responsible for collecting the work in person, or covering the postage fee (should the work need to be posted). If you decide you want to remove your work from the gallery, you are free to do so at any time and a final payment will be processed the following month.
